Charlotte Soccer Academy Tryout and Post-Tryout Information Summer Schedule

How do I find out if my child made a team?

No offers will be made at the tryout venue. To be fair to all players, the coaches must spend every possible moment evaluating the players. At the venue, the coaches will be unavailable to answer questions or discuss teams or players.

If your child is selected for a team, the team's coach or the age group DOC will contact you by telephone with an offer. He/she will instruct you that you have 24 hours from that time to accept the position. All parents/players will be called no later than 48 hours after the last age group tryout session, whether they have made a team or not.

How do we commit to a team?

First, tell the coach or DOC that calls that you will accept the offer. Please make a note of the team and coach name at that time. If you want to think it over, please call or email the coach within the 24 hour period to guarantee your spot. Second, you must register online and pay the commitment fee. If you do not register for the team and pay the commitment fee online within 24 hours, you will not be guaranteed the spot you were offered, nor will you receive important email updates from the club.

When do I meet my team and coach?

If your child is placed on a team, it is very important that you and your child attend the post-tryout meeting for your age group. At these meetings, you will meet the CSA Board and the DOCs, your coach and your teammates. You will complete important registration paperwork and select uniform sizes and numbers. Meeting location, time and dates will be posted on our website and emailed to players who have financially committed to their team.

CSA Uniform Policy:

CSA will provide uniforms for new U9/U10 Academy Players, all ECNL Players and all US Dev Academy Players only. All other players new to CSA must purchase a uniform kit. Adidas field uniform includes 2 game jerseys, 2 shorts, 2 pr. sock (\$145 Youth, \$160 Adult). Adidas GK uniform includes 2 game jerseys, 1 short, 2 pr. socks (\$140 Youth, \$180 Adult).

Club fees for schedules 1 through 11 above do not include team-specific fees for referees, tournaments, etc which are paid directly to the team. This is an additional cost.

The commitment fee is non-refundable. Upon commitment to a team, you are financially responsible for all Club fees as stated for the entire playing year.

Beginning August 1, 2010, players will not be released from CSA unless all Club fees are paid in full and team fees are up to date at the time of the request.

Players with a season ending injury may be eligible for a refund or credit with the amount to be determined on a case-by-case basis.

Players moving more than 50 miles during the season are eligible for a refund with the amount to be determined.

Requests for releases and withdrawals must be presented in writing to admin@charlottesocceracademy.com.

All fees will be paid when payment is due. Statements will not be mailed. Any payments that are delinquent may be cause to remove player card from the team. If this should occur, a service charge of \$50 to reinstate a player card may be charged.

Returned checks are subject to a \$50 fee. Following a returned check, additional payments must be made in cash or credit card.
